On behalf of the CMD BSNL General manager Telecom, Mandya Telecom District invites sealed tenders (packing PVC tape / sealing wax) for the repair of Power plant modules (SMPS) 25 Amps and 100 Amps capacity of any make in Mandya Telecom District.

- 1. PERIOD OF TENDER:** One year from the date of agreement (until otherwise specified) or completion of work put to tender which ever is earlier. How ever GMT Mandya has full powers to extend it for one more year or till calling next tender,
- 2. MODE OF PAYMENT:** Tender document can be purchased by paying cost of bid document in cash or DD drawn in favour of BSNL Mandya Telecom District payable at Mandya. Bid security is to be paid in the form of crossed DD issued by a schedule bank, Drawn in F/O BSNL Mandya payable at Mandya.
- 3. TENDER DOCUMENT :** The Tender forms and other details may be had from SDE(PLG) O/o GMT Mandya on all working days on payment of Rs575/-(Rs. Five hundred seventy five only) BSNL Mandya by cash or DD. 1. ELIGIBILITY:

- 1.1 The Tenderers having experience in the field of manufacturing /Repairing of the Power Plant SMPS Modules of any make are eligible to take part in the tender.
- 1.2 Tenderers have to enclose the experience certificate, DD for an amount of Rs 10,000/-(Rs.Ten thousand only) towards payment of EMD along with tender documents.
- 1.3 The tender documents without the above documents are liable for rejection.
- 1.4 The tenderer is exempted from payment of EMD if the unit is registered by NSIC for repair of SMPS units, and in such a case they have to submit details of their registration with NSIC/copy of valid registration certificate, which is current.
- 1.6 The tenderer has to enclose service tax registration certificate.
- 1.7 The tenderer has to enclose IT Clearance certificate for the financial year 2007-2008

2. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

2.1 Tenderer will submit the tender in two parts as follows

Part -A Technical bid :-

- 1) Tender document duly signed with seal
- 2) EMD for Rs.10,000/-(Rs.Ten thousand only) in the form of DD.
- 3) Experience certificate
- 4) IT clearance certificate
- 5) Service Tax registration certificate

Part-B Financial bid :-

Financial bid to be detached and should keep in separate cover duly sealed PVC/WAX superscribed as "Financial Bid"

Part-A should be kept in one cover duly sealed, Part-B should be kept in another cover and Part-A and Part-B covers to be kept in one common cover duly sealed (PVC/WAX) and should be addressed to Sri. G.Thimmarayappa, AGM (PLG), O/o GMT, Mandya and to be dropped in the tender box before the closing (date &time) as mentioned in the NIT.

The tender application can also be sent by Registered post with AD addressed to Sri. G.Thimmarayappa, AGM(PLG)O/o GMT MANDYA and it should reach him on or before the due date and time. The tenderer is to ensure the delivery of the bids at the correct address. The department shall not be held responsible for delay in delivery of bid. The slit of the tender box will be sealed immediately after the specified time for receipt of tender.

3. OPENING OF BIDS

- 3.1 The bids shall be opened in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives who choose to attend, at 15:00 Hrs on due date. The bidder's representatives who are present, shall sign in attendance register.
- 3.2 One representative for any bidder shall be permitted to attend the bid opening.
- 3.3 The Bids shall be opened in the following manner:
 - 3.3.1 The bid opening committee shall count the number of bids and assign serial numbers to the bids. For example, if 10 tenders have been received the bid shall be numbered as 1 of 10, 2 of 10 etc. All the members of the committee shall initial on the outer envelopes /bid papers of all the bids with date.
 - 3.3.1.1 The successful bidder in technical bid will be called for financial bid opening, the date of financial bid opening will be communicated separately.

4. EVALUATION AND COMPARISON OF SUBSTANTIALLY RESPONSIVE BIDS:

- 4.1 The BSNL shall evaluate in detail and compare the bids as per rates quoted in the financial bid.
- 4.2 In case of ambiguity of rates quoted, the rate quoted in words will be taken as the rate.

5. CONTACTING BSNL:

- 5.1 No bidder shall try to influence the BSNL on any matter relating to its bid from the time of bid opening till the time the tender is awarded.
- 5.2 Any effort by the bidder to modify his bid or influence the BSNL in the bid evaluation of BSNL, bid comparison or the tender award decisions shall result in the rejection of the bid.

6. AWARD OF TENDER:

- 6.1 The BSNL shall consider award of tender only to those eligible bidders whose offers have been found technically, commercially and financially acceptable.
- 6.2 The work against the tender is for one year's requirement and the terms and conditions of this tender shall be operative for a period of one year from the date of signing of agreement between BSNL and the tenderer.

7. RIGHT OF BSNL TO VARY QUANTUM OF WORK:

BSNL, at the time of award of work under the tender, reserves the right to decrease or increase the work by up to 25% of the total quantum of work specified in the schedule of requirements without any change in the rates or other terms and conditions.

8. BSNL RIGHT TO ACCEPT ANY BID AND TO REJECT ANY OF ALL BIDS:

- 8.1 BSNL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids, at any time prior to award of tender without assigning any reason what-so-ever and without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders on the grounds for the action of BSNL.
- 8.2 BSNL reserves the right not to choose the lowest bidder without giving any reason.

9. ISSUE OF LETTER OF INTENT:

- 9.1 The issue of letter of intent shall constitute the intention of BSNL to enter into the tender with the bidder. Letter of intent will be issued as offer to the successful bidder.
- 9.2 The bidder shall within 7 days of issue of letter of intent, give his acceptance provided with the bid documents.

10. SIGNING OF AGREEMENT:

- 10.1 The signing of agreement shall constitute the award of tender on the bidder. The agreement with the successful bidder shall be signed by BSNL within a week.
- 10.2 As soon as the tender is approved by the competent authority, the bid security deposited by the successful bidder shall be compulsorily converted into the performance security deposit, and the bidder has to pay balance performance security (SD) Viz Rs 40,000/- (Rupees Forty thousand only).
- 10.3 In case of unsuccessful bidders, the EMD will be refunded within one month from the date of opening of tender.
- 10.4 Total performance security deposit of Rs.50,000/- (Rs Fifty thousand only) (Including EMD). The security Deposit will be held with BSNL during the period of contract and warranty period of the last batch of work order and it will not bear any interest.

11. PENALTY CLAUSE:

11.1 Delays in the tenderer's performance:

- 11.1.1 The time allowed for completion of the work as entered in the tender shall be strictly adhered by the tenderer and shall be deemed to be the most important aspect of the tender. The work shall, throughout the stipulated period of tender, be proceeded with all due diligence to achieve the desired progress uniformly,
- 11.1.2 If the faulty unit is not attended within 3 days of reporting, 5% of the repair charges will be deducted on daily basis upto a maximum of 25%.

12. PENALTY FOR DELAYED SUBMISSION OF BILLS.

12.1 "The bills should be submitted by the tenderer within one month from the date of execution of work and no payment will be made for the delayed submitted bills.

13 The Divisional Engineer in-charge of work shall issue show cause notice to the tenderer giving details of lapses, violation of terms and conditions of the tender, willful delays or suspension of work or slow progress of work directing the tenderer to take corrective action.

A definite time schedule for corrective action shall be mentioned in the show cause notice. If the tenderer fails to take corrective action within the stipulated time frame, the divisional engineer in-charge shall submit a draft along with a detailed report to the competent authority who had accepted the tender.

14. INDEMNITIES:

14.1 The Tenderer shall at all times hold the BSNL harmless and indemnify from against all action, suits, proceedings, works, cost, damages, charges claims and demands of every nature and descriptions, brought or procured against the BSNL, its officers and employees and forthwith upon demand and without protect or demur to pay to the BSNL any and all losses and damages and cost (inclusive between attorney and client) and all costs incurred in endorsing this or any other indemnity or security which the BSNL may now or at any time have relative to the work or the Tenderers obligation or in protecting or endorsing its right in any suit on other legal proceeding, charges and expense and liabilities resulting from or incidental or in protecting or endorsing its right in any suit on other legal proceeding, charges and expense and liabilities resulting from or incidental or in connection with injury, damages of the Tenderer or damage to property resulting

from or arising out of or in any way connected with or incidental to the operations caused by the tender documents. In addition the tenderer shall reimburse the BSNL or pay to the BSNL forthwith on demand without protest or demur all cost, charges and expenses and losses and damages otherwise incurred by it in consequences of any claim, damages and actions which may be brought against the BSNL arising out of or incidental to or in connection with the operation covered by the Tenderer.

- 14.2 The tenderer shall at his own at the BSNL's request defend any suit or other proceeding asserting a claim covered by this indemnity, but shall not settle compound or compromise any suit or other finding without first consulting the BSNL.

15. FORCE MAJEURE :

- 15.1 If any time, during the continuance of the Tender, the performance in whole or in part by either party or any obligation under this tender shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any war, or hostility, acts of the public enemy, civil commotion sabotage, fires, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lockouts or act of God (Here in after referred to as events) provided notice of happenings, of any such event be entitled to terminate this tender nor shall either party have any such claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance and work done under the Tender shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event may come to an end or cease to exist, and the decision of BSNL as to whether the work have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive, provided further that if the performance, in whole or part of any obligation under this tender is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days either party may, at his option terminate the Tender.
- 15.2 Provided also that if the Tender is terminated under this clause, BSNL, shall be at liberty to take over from the Tenderer at a price to be fixed by BSNL, which shall be final, all unused, undamaged and acceptable materials, bought out components and stores in the course of execution of the Tender, in possession of the Tenderer at the time of such termination of such portions thereof as BSNL may deem fit excepting such materials bought out components and stores as the Tenders may with the concurrence of BSNL elect to retain.

16. ARBITRATION:

- 16.1 In the event of any question, dispute or difference arising under this agreement or in connection there-with except as to matter the decision of which is specifically provided under this agreement, the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of the Chief General Manager, (Karnataka Circle) or his representative. The agreement to appoint an arbitrator will be in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. There will be no objection to any such appointment that the arbitrator is BSNL Servant or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as BSNL servants or that he has to deal with the matter to which the agreement relates or that in the course of his duties as BSNL servants he expressed views on all or any of the matter under dispute. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. In the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred, being transferred or vacating his office or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever such Chief General Manager or the said officer shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the agreement and the person so appointed shall be entitled to proceed from the stage at which it was left out by his predecessors.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF TENDER

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 The work shall be accepted only after proper testing carried out by Officer, designated by BSNL,
- 1.2 BSNL reserves the right to disqualify such bidders who have a record of not meeting tender obligations against earlier tenders entered into with BSNL.
- 1.3 BSNL reserves the right to black list a bidder for a suitable period in case he fails to honor his bid without sufficient grounds.
- 1.4 Any clarification issued by BSNL, in response to query raised by prospective bidders before opening of bid shall form an integral part of bid documents and it may amount to amendment of relevant clause of the bid documents.
- 1.5 Tender will be evaluated separately for both the items given in the price schedule (Financial Bid).
- 1.6 All work to be executed under the Tender shall be executed under the direction and subject to the approval in all respects by the Divisional Engineer or Sub-Divisional Engineer at site who shall be entitled to direct at what point or points and what manner they are to be commenced, and from time to time carried on.
- 1.7 The work in each section may be split up between two or more Tenderers or accept any tender in part and not entirely if considered expedient by GMT, Mandya.
- 1.8 If the Tenderer shall desire on extension of time for completion of the work on the grounds of unavoidable hindrance in execution of work or any other ground he shall apply in writing to the Divisional Engineer within 3 days of the date of hindrance on account of which he desires such extension as aforesaid. In this regard the decision of GMT, Mandya shall be final.
- 1.9 If at any time after the commencement of work, BSNL may feel that execution of whole or part of work, as specified in the tender is not required to be carried out, then BSNL shall give notice in writing of the fact to the Tenderer, who shall have no claim to any payment of compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived in consequence of the full amount of the work not having been carried out neither shall he have any claim for compensation by reason of alterations having been made in the original specifications, drawings, designs and instructions which shall involve any curtailment of the work originally contemplated.

- 1.10 Whenever any claims against the Tenderer for the payment of a sum of money arises out of or under the Tender, BSNL shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating in part or whole the security deposit of the Tenderer, and to sell any BSNL promissory notes, etc., forming the whole or part of such security or running / Final bill pending against any Tender with BSNL. In the event of the security being insufficient or if no security has been taken from the tenderer, then the balance or the total sum recoverable as the case may be, shall be deducted from any sum then due or which at any time there after may become due to the tenderer under this or any other Tender with BSNL. Should this sum be not sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable the tenderer shall pay to BSNL on demand the balance remaining due.
- 1.11 No official or officer employed in Engineering or administrative duties in an Engineering Department or any other Department of the BSNL of India is allowed to work as a Tenderer for a period of two years after his retirement from BSNL service without the previous permission of the BSNL of India. This Tender is liable to be cancelled if either the Tenderer or any of his employee is found at any time to be such a person who hadn't obtained the permission of BSNL of India as aforesaid before submission of the engagement in the Tenderer's service as the case may be.
- 1.12 Interpretation of the Tender document:**
- 1.12.1 The representative of GMT, Mandya and the Tenderer shall in so far as possible by mutual consultation, try to decide upon the meaning and intent of the Tender document. In case of disagreement the matter shall be referred to GMT, Mandya whose decision shall be final. Any charges in the Tender documents shall be set forth in writing by the representatives of the parties hereto. It shall be the Tenderer's responsibility to thoroughly familiarize all of his supervisory personnel with contents of all the Tender documents.
- 1.13 General Conditions:**
- 1.13.1 The General Manager Telecom, Mandya can get the work done through the department also, if the situation so demands.
- 1.13.2 No spare parts should be removed from one unit and placed in another unit either for testing or for repair.
- 1.13.3 Tenderer has to repair all the units irrespective of faults including burnt cases and **none of the units should be kept/ returned unrepaired.**
- 1.13.4 Tenderer should repair the modules at the place wherever the unit is reported faulty or at the place of choice of GM, Mandya. **refer annexure.**
- 1.13.5 They have to repair the power plant modules **irrespective of the make**, however the capacities are **25 Amps & 100 Amps modules.**

- 1.13.6 The repaired modules shall carry a **warranty period of six months**. Any repaired unit becoming faulty during the period of warranty is to be repaired free of cost immediately after reporting by the concerned section in charge.
- 1.13.7 The EMD of the tenderer will be forfeited if he fails to enter in to an agreement with the BSNL **within seven days** after the receipt of the information for entering into agreement.
- 1.13.8 The rates quoted by the tenderer will include cost of the material, their transportation and repair/service charges, and service tax , cess and any other charges levied by the state-central.
- 1.13.9 The repaired modules should be tested in the presence of concerned SDE/JTO and service report to be obtained by the tenderer.
- 1.13.10 The tenderer shall use the components manufactured by a reputed company for the repair of modules.
- 1.13.11 This tender will also be applicable for any new power plants added to the list of present/new stations within the SSA. Successful tenderer should attend to any fault reported by the sub-divisional engineers in charge of the installations within three days of reporting of the same. No extra payment will be made for the visit for clearing the fault when reported by the field officers.
- 1.13.12 The Payment will be made by the *General Manager Telecom, Mandya*, after the work is done satisfactorily and certified by the respective sub-divisional officer/Engineers/Divisional Engineers by crossed cheque on submission of the bills by the tenderer in triplicate, duly stamped and pre-receipted to the officer in charge. The bills must be addressed to the *General Manager Telecom, Mandya* and submitted through the respective sub-divisional Engineers/officers. Signature of the concerned SDE/DE is to be obtained.
- 1.13.13 KST/CST will be deducted from each bill apart from the Income Tax and Surcharge on Income Tax as applicable.
- 1.13.14 Service tax, cess component should be shown separately while submitting the bills for payment

2 **QUALITY OF WORK:**

- 2.1 BSNL shall be the final judge of the quality of the work and the satisfaction of the Department in respect thereof set forth in the tender documents. Laxity or failure to enforce compliance with the Tender documents by the Department and / or its representative shall not manifest a change or intent of waiver, the intention, being that,notwithstanding the same, the tenderer shall be and remain responsible for complete and proper compliance with the Tender documents and the specification there in. The representative of *GMT, Mandya* has the right to prohibit the use of men and any tools, materials and equipment which in his opinion

do not produce work or performance meet the requirement of the Tender documents.

3. TAXES AND DUTIES:

- 3.1 Tenderer shall pay all rates, levies, fees royalties, taxes and duties payable or arising out of, by virtue of or in connection with and / or incidental to the Tender or any of the obligations of the parties in terms of the Tenderer documents and / or in respect of the works or operations or any part thereof to be performed by the Tenderer and the Tenderer shall indemnify BSNL, against the same or any default by the Tenderer in the payment thereof.

4. LABOUR WELFARE MEASURES AND WORKMAN COMPENSATION:

4.1 Obtaining License before commencement of work:

The tenderer shall obtain a valid labour license under the Tender Labour (R & A) Act 1970 and the Tender Labour (Regulation and Abolition) central rules 1971, before commencement of the work, and continue to have a valid license until the completion of duration of the tender. The tenderer shall also abide by the provisions of the Chief Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act 1986. Any failure to fulfill this requirement shall attract the penal provisions of this Tender arising out of the resultant non-execution of work.

4.2 Tenderers Labour Regulations:

4.2.1 Working Hours.

- 4.2.2 Normally working hours of an employee should not exceed 9 hours a day. The working day will be so arranged that inclusive of interval of rest, if any, it shall not spread over more than 12 hours on any day.

5. **Jurisdiction of Contract:** The jurisdiction of the tender shall be for zone wise. The telephone exchange areas in different zones shall be as under. If any additional telephone exchange is planned, the same shall be included in the zone in the vicinity of concerned keeping in view the logistics of carrying out the work.
